

Jane Hammer Holmgren Scholarship Application Form

Chapter Recommendation

Program Overview

The Jane Hammer Holmgren Scholarship recognizes an outstanding Montana woman who is pursuing a degree, certification, graduate or postgraduate work in the field of elementary education. It is given in memory of Jane Hammer Holmgren who was an elementary teacher.

Eligibility

A P.E.O. chapter may nominate an outstanding candidate that meets the following criteria:

- ☆ Has completed at least two years of college.
- ☆ Is pursuing a bachelor's degree, a master's degree or postgraduate work in elementary education and early childhood and will be working with students rather than in administration.
- ☆ On-line programs in accredited schools will be considered.
- ☆ Must confirm enrollment as of July 1 of the award year to be eligible for scholarship disbursement.
- ☆ Must be a U.S. or Canadian citizen or a legal permanent resident.

Completing the Nomination Packet

- ☆ The application must be legibly typed.
- ☆ The selection committee will consider only information included in this nomination packet, which should include the application, an essay, two letters of recommendation, and an unofficial recent transcript.
- ☆ Deadline for all applications is February 15. Items must be postmarked by February 15. Items received after the deadline, or incomplete applications, will not be considered.
- ☆ The funding is for the following academic year.
- ☆ Mail or email the complete packet to the state chair of the Jane Hammer Holmgren Scholarship Committee as listed on page OC-5 (Officer and Committee) section of the Montana Proceedings notebook.
- ☆ The JHH Committee will notify all submitting chapters and applicants when a decision has been made.
