Visitors: Register as a P.E.O. Visitor if you are a member of the Sisterhood and attending as a non-voting member of convention. This includes all convention workers and convention committee members; please indicate meals also.

Guests: Register as a Non-P.E.O. Guest if you are attending an event with a P.E.O. This includes BILs, family and friends. Indicate the meals you plan to attend and include payment.

All attendees must register so a name badge can be prepared. Attendees include those who are convention workers, family members attending events, and sisters coming for any part of the weekend.

Chapter Delegates (1st & 2nd): A complete meal package must be reserved for each chapter delegate. MSC will pay for the first delegate's meal package. The chapter is responsible for the second delegate's meal package and lodging for both delegates. Hotel rooms are available at Fairmont Hot Springs Resort and others as listed on page 7.

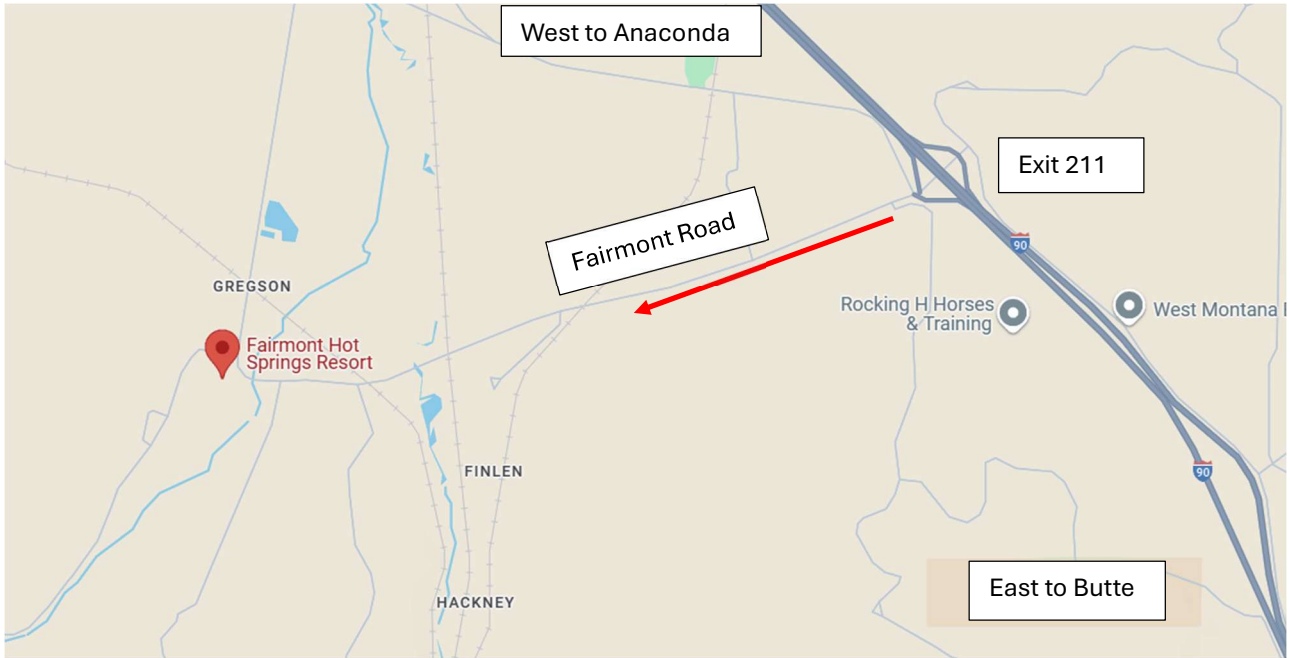
