- #7**  **S/P/D Officers Coach You** S/P/D officers are very accessible, including during officer workshops and periodic official visits.



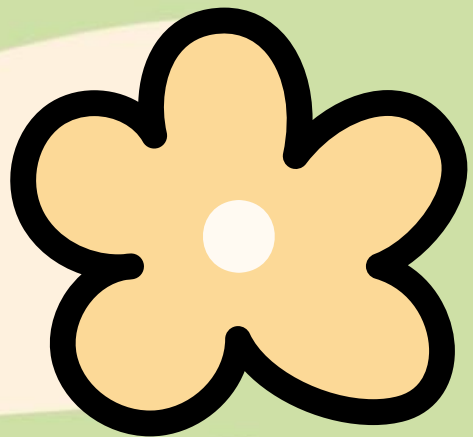
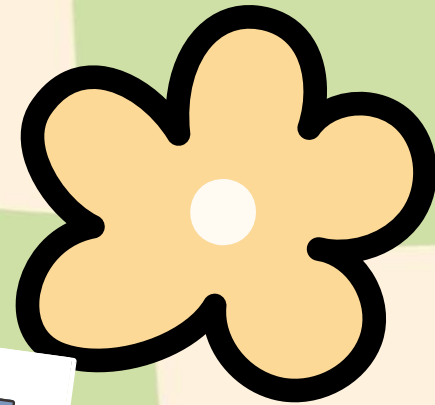
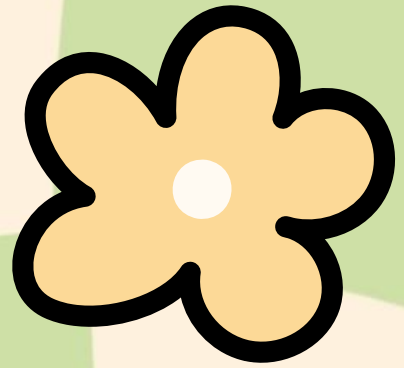
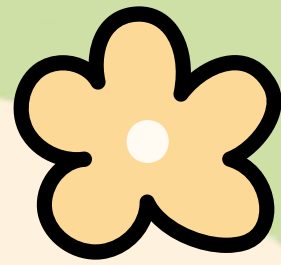
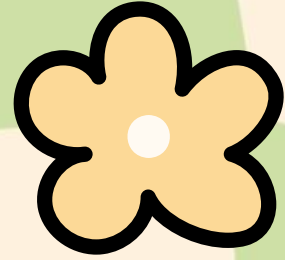
## You SHOULD because...
